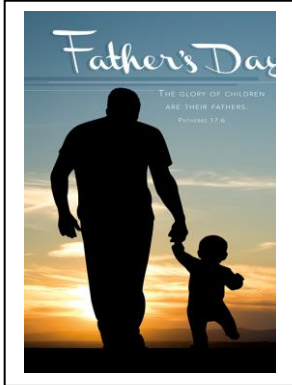

Father's Day began as an act of a single father – Henry Jackson Smart. His wife died while giving birth to their sixth child, leaving Mr. Smart to raise six children, including one newborn, in rural Washington State. A single father raising six children on his own showed the self-sacrificial love of fathers of all kinds everywhere. Years later one of his daughters, Sonora Smart Doddy heard a Mother's Day sermon and decided there should be a Father's Day also. The first Father's Day was June 19, 1910. In 1966 President Lyndon Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the third Sunday of June as Father's Day. Today let us honor the traditional fathers, single fathers, foster fathers, and our own fathers.

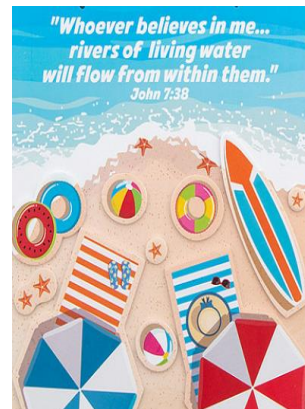
PENTECOST SUNDAY, June 5
