### Reminders:

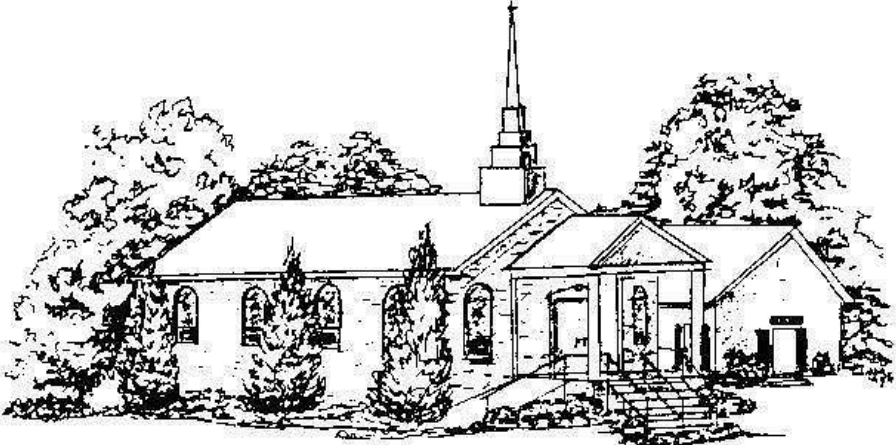
- Masks are available for anyone while inside the church buildings.
